**INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXAMS**

- You will be allocated a seat for the duration of the exams.
- If you have an exam in session 1 and have another exam in session 3 then you must remain in school and REVISE SILENTLY in the Assembly Hall. You may only leave school once all exams for that day are completed.
- As with external exams, there are NO MOBILE PHONES OR WATCHES ALLOWED IN THE EXAM ROOM, PLEASE LEAVE THESE AT HOME OR IN YOUR LOCKER.
- You will only be allowed a small clear pencil case on your desk.
- No food is to be eaten in the exam hall. You may bring 1 bottle of water only.
- Talking, cheating, or having materials in your possession which pertain to you examination, will result in 0 marks.
- As per GCSE/AS/A Levels, you will not be permitted to leave any exam early.
- If you choose to come into school to revise on a day when you have no exams, then you must remain in school until the end of the day.
- You must note the date/time/location of your language oral(s) on this timetable. It is entirely your responsibility to ensure you attend as appropriate.
