Eg 2 On Tuesday 13th, If you study Drama, but not Chemistry or Physics, you do not need to come to school until 1pm.

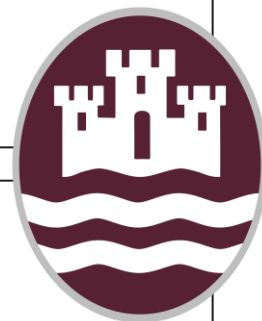

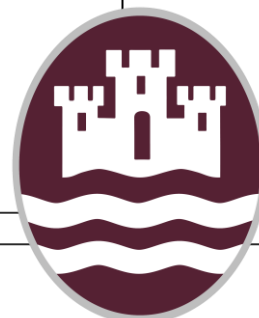
